11/30/16	Students asked for a fajita night.	We are looking into it.	We are considering a day to have this, will keep you posted once we have the date. Discussing with Chef Lauren.
11/30/16	Students want to see hot sauce at Food Court.	We do have hot sauce packets.	Hot Sauce Packets are now available at the registers when checking out.
11/30/16	Would like to know what is happening with the Lion's Den line.	We understand your concern.	The second make station has arrived and is in place. This should help with the SubConnection line.
11/30/16	Students agree that a 15 to 20-minute wait in our dining facilities is reasonable.	We think this is a good idea.	We are working towards this goal.
11/30/16	Students are concerned that the salad toppings at the SubConnection will go too quickly.	We understand your concern.	Using sales data we project how many salads will be sold. We prep additional pans of toppings and there is always plenty on hand. We are also offering MTO Salads at SubConnection starting Monday, February 6.

11/30/16	Students feel that the portions of food at Quimby's are not the same and believe it is based on gender and people's sizes.	This is not the case.	We follow pre-established portioning guidelines.
11/30/16	Students want three size cups for cold beverages at the Education Café.	We have 3 sizes cups available for hot beverage but we only have 1 size for cold.	We have 2 cold beverage sizes available, regular and large.
11/30/16	Students requested to have strawberries in addition to the other fruits available.	Strawberries have a very short season making them hard to get in the fall and winter seasons. Sourcing strawberries from un-approved farms, that are not on our sustainable list can cause quality issues.	We try to stay with in-season and local fruit as much as possible.
11/30/16	Students would like to know why they only can use one plate at Eickhoff and when they go back for seconds they must get another plate.	We understand your concern.	We do not reuse plates that have been served on. Doing so would be against Health Department regulations. These regulations seek to control the possibility of cross contamination.
11/30/16	Students requested to have a cold coffee dispenser for iced coffee in Eickhoff.	We are looking into it.	Director of Dining Operations is currently looking into the possibility of iced coffee.

11/30/16	Students want to know if coffee could be offered in the Lion's Den and can it be sold during Meal Equiv.	There might be a space issue but will look into this possibility.	Due to space limitations, coffee will be available at Fresh Pride Café and Traditions in BSC, but not the Lion's Den.
11/30/16	Students would like to know if we have cinnamon bread and hot chocolate packets in the C-Store?	We never sold cinnamon bread in the C-Store and we are looking into getting the hot chocolate packets.	Hot Chocolate packets are available at TDubs. Currently featuring a Mindful hot chocolate recipe at the C-Store. In regards to cinnamon bread, we are looking into this with the vendor.
11/30/16	Students would like to have sautéed vegetables in TDubs.	We are looking into it.	We have sautéed vegetables available at the Mexican station.
11/30/16	If a student loses their ID, what should be done for access into Eickhoff?	We understand your concern.	Students must report to the main office in Eickhoff that their ID is lost.
11/30/16	Students will like to know why they cannot buy alcohol with their meal plan card.	We understand your concern.	The campus cannot pay for students to drink alcohol.
