Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I get the exemption on my Flames Pass?

- A. Fill out the attached form.
- B. The Liberty Dining dietitian will determine if an exemption will be granted or not.
- C. If not satisfied with the decision on your exemption, you may appeal to the Office of Disability Accommodation Support.

2. Once I have the exemption, how do I use it on campus?

- A. If using at an ordering kiosk, click on the GIO icon (🚫) first, then follow the on screen ordering prompts.
- B. If ordering with an employee, verbally explain that you are apart of the GIO program. You may also need to show verification on your Liberty Flames Pass.
