# Dining Announcements

## Overall Dining Updates:

- Mines Market is limited to students living in the Residence Halls only
- Mines Market will have limited seating capacity
- Self-serve stations now served by an employee
- Increased take-out options available and encouraged
- Students are encouraged to download the free Bite App by Sodexo to view menus at Mines Market prior to arriving
