

Campus Dining Service Modifications—3/16/20

In response to the Corona virus outbreak, and in keeping with the University's recent operational changes, Campus Dining will be implementing these modifications to our services beginning Monday, March 16 and continuing through April 3, or until further notice.

All Retail Dining Locations Closed as of Monday, March 16

Retail units include Katora Café, Panera Bread, Hissho Sushi, Vocelli Pizza, Bodacious Burgers and the Simply To Go Market.

The Top of the UC will be open at specific times. Meal service will be as follows:

Monday—Friday

Breakfast	8:30 a.m. to 10 a.m.
Lunch	11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.
Dinner	5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Saturday & Sunday

Brunch	11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.
Dinner	5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

All Dining will be “Take-Out” only at the Top of the UC

There will be no “dine in” options. The Dining team will serve food in take-out containers. Students must eat their meals someplace outside of the University Center in order to avoid the gathering of a large number of students in close proximity to one another.

Take-out containers will be provided by our servers and handed to you when all of your food selections have been placed in them. Once a box has been handed to you servers can't take it back to add more items. If you need additional items an additional box will be provided.

Take Out Cups will be available from our servers behind the lines. Ask a server for a cup and lid, then fill your cup with your desired beverage and take it out with you.

Disposable Eating Utensils, Salt, Pepper and Napkin Sets will be in bins on the Graze bar.

Condiment Packets will also be available in bins on the Graze Bar

Food Stations & Options at the Top of the UC

All food items will be served from the Grill, Chefs' Fare Carving Station, Chefs' Fare case, Joe Stacks Deli, and the Magic Oven. At Lunch/Brunch and Dinner the following options will be available:

- Simple Servings / Allergen Free Meals—at the Chefs' Fare Carving Station
- Full “Comfort Food” or international cuisine meals—at the Chefs' Fare Case
- A Vegan and/or Vegetarian entrée at the Chefs' Fare Case
- Grilled burgers or other sandwiches —at the Grill or Chefs' Fare Case
- Made-To-Order Deli Sandwiches—At Joe Stacks
- Made-To-Order Salads—at Joe Stacks Deli Case
- Desserts, including vegan and gluten free, at Magic Oven
- Gluten-Free buns & breads—are available upon request at the Grill, Joe Stacks or Chefs Fare
