

Residential Dining Hall Updates

Seminole Dining laid out a three-phased approach for re-opening campus dining locations prior to the start of the school year. We have been operating in Phase 1 with “To-Go” style service and no indoor seating. Seminole Dining, in conjunction with the University, has made the decision to move to Phase 2 of its plan which includes reduced dine-in seating beginning Monday, October 5th. This phase includes the continuation of following social distancing guidelines and the requirement of masks in all areas of the dining locations except for when seated to eat. To continue to ensure the health and safety of our guests and dining team, Suwannee will close daily from 3:30PM – 4:30PM to deep clean and sanitize the dining hall between meal periods. In order to facilitate the turn over, Suwannee will close Saturday at 8pm.

Residential dining locations will resume the use of china and cups. We will continue to use our pre-packaged cutlery kits. Guests will have the option to take their meals to-go using the required OZZI program. This process includes:

- Using the OZZI green reusable containers
(Guests may fill up to 2 OZZI O2GO containers per meal swipe.)
- Guests will be asked to wear gloves to help prevent cross contamination when receiving food from multiple stations in one visit.
- Guests who wish to dine-in and take food to-go, will be required to use a 2nd meal swipe.

Retail Location Updates

Retail locations will begin adding seating in all locations at a reduced level.

These changes are currently being implemented and will be fully deployed by Monday, October 5th.

Changes for 1851: During home football games, 1851 will be closed and will reopen on Sunday at normal business hours.

Garnet & Go will close at 1pm on Friday, October 2nd and remain closed for the rest of the semester.
